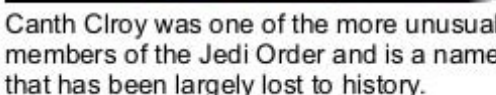

Canth Clroy was one of the more unusual members of the Jedi Order and is a name that has been largely lost to history.

Cloy was one of the few Jedi who went into training later in life. Cloy was discovered by Jedi Knight Ki-Adi-Mundi when he stumbled upon Cloy using his latent force ability to make a living on the streets of Coruscant. Cloy would earn tips by entertaining pedestrians with "puppet shows" where he'd use the force to animate children's toys making them dance or fight each other. Ki-Adi-Mundi was so taken by Cloy's abilities with the force he considered making him his first Padawan learner. However, this is when Cloy began demonstrating the trait that set him apart from his fellow Jedi. He wasn't serious enough. He repeatedly asked Ki-Adi-Mundi if he was from France and this enraged the cone-headed Jedi to the degree where he disowned Cloy and repeatedly referred to him derisively as "That Cloy fellow."

Ciroy then passed from master to master until Jedi Master Yoda took over and finally completed his training. Some think that the methods used to help Ciroy learn the ways of the Jedi came in handy when Yoda trained an older than usual Luke Skywalker on the gas planet of Dagobah.

However, even after completing his training, Clroy never completely adopted the even-temperament and staid demeanor of most Jedi. He liked to play little pranks on his fellow Jedi in an attempt to loosen them up. His favorite was to poke a little hole in their cups so whatever they were drinking would spill all over the place. He frequently asked Jedi Master Kenobi what exactly it was that Obi had "won" which Kenobi thought was slightly funny the first time he heard it but not much after that.

Clroy was a master of an arcane Jedi skill which he called the "Jedi Mind Blast" in which he would overwhelm and confuse opponents by projecting an array of trivial facts and out-of-context thoughts that would befuddle his opponents giving Clroy the advantage in hand-to-hand combat. Clroy was good with a light saber and a decent pilot when he flew alone. With passengers he tended to be a bit erratic.

While protecting a Senator who had become the target for assassination Clroy encountered three Plutdroid or combat droids similar to the bounty hunter IG-88. Clroy found that his "Jedi Mind Blast" did not work on the droids and was nearly killed. To alleviate that problem, he developed the cybernetic helmet he wore allowing him to use the Mind Blast on droids as well as organic beings.

Cloy missed the Battle of Geonosis because he accompanied Yoda to investigate the cloning facility on Kamino. Upon seeing the clone army for the first time, Cloy gasped "There are a lot of clones here." Master Yoda nodded in agreement uttering, "A lot of clones, there are." Yoda left Cloy behind to monitor things at the facility when he left with the clone army to rescue the Jedi at Geonosis.

It was after the battle, during a debriefing, that Clroy earned the ire of Mace Windu. At a Jedi meeting, the Jedi Master described his defeat of the Bounty Hunter Jango Fett. At the story's conclusion, Clroy quipped "So, you just got Fett up with him?" The icy silence afterwards was deafening but Clroy didn't even notice as he broke into what he thought was a witty chorus of "Jango Fett, Jango Fett, Jango lost his head. Oh what fun it is to see a Bounty Hunter de-ad."

After that Clroy was sent on a diplomatic mission to Yavin. Clroy couldn't help but laugh when he arrived to discover Yavin was actually an uninhabited gas giant. Master Windu had played a joke on the erstwhile Jedi. Clroy spent a few weeks poking about the ruins of a temple on the planet's fourth moon before heading back to Coruscant. Clroy told a number of people about his adventures in the ruins and this knowledge proved useful later on when the Rebellion was searching for a place to hide their base.

Despite his sometimes eccentric behavior Clroy was as worthy as any Jedi. During the Clone Wars Clroy served admirably. He was badly injured defeating a clone of Darth Maul. After regaining his health, he continually told people about how "Darth mauled him." The story usually drew groans from his fellow Jedi.

There are also stories that Croy was approached by Darth Sidious as a possible apprentice but Sidious decided to look elsewhere when Croy informed the Dark Lord that if he did turn to the dark side, he'd want to be called "Darth Meanie."

It is also thought that Clroy may have been among the first Jedi hunted down and destroyed by Anakin Skywalker as he started down the path that transformed him into Darth Vader. Skywalker was paired with Clroy on several assignments during the Clone Wars because Yoda hoped that by pairing the overly-serious Skywalker with the irreverent Clroy might rub off on one another. Instead Clroy only angered the soon-to-be Sith lord by repeatedly whispering, "I'm not a slave, I'm a real boy" and then denying he said anything. Another one of his favorites was to point up in the sky and say "Look, an angel." Clroy thought it was all very funny. Skywalker did not.

When the purge of the Jedi began, Clroy was one of the first to vanish. It is unknown whether he met his destiny at the hands of Darth Vader or if he escaped and went into hiding. The actual final fate of Clroy is unknown.
